 - My Message: ...
 - My Contribution: ...
- One possible (proven) storyline for the presentation is:
 - Introduce yourself
 - Describe the context of your work
 - Shortly describe prior work in this area
 - Specify the problem/challenge you want to address and why it is important/useful
 - Sketch the way to the solution
 - Then follow with the material you want to present

- Present a coherent conclusion, summarizing and assessing your results
- Describe your contribution
- If applicable: Sketch the next steps of your work
- If applicable: Credit anybody who helped you in your work
- Appendix: The most important sources you have used (Literature, Web-references)
- Timing: 20 minutes max. for the presentation (= approx. 20 slides, not counting title slide and reference slides) and 5 minutes for feedback
